

A (*Flesh*)

- a. 11 Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles **in the flesh**,
 - b. who are called **Uncircumcision**
 - b'. by that which is called the **Circumcision**
- a'. **in the flesh** made by hands;

B. (*Strangers*)

- a. 12 That at that time
 - b. ye were **without** Christ,
 - c. being **aliens** from the commonwealth of Israel,
 - c'. and **strangers** from the covenants of promise,
 - b'. having no hope, and **without** God
- a'. in the world:

C. (*In Christ*)

- a. 13 But now **in Christ** Jesus
 - b. ye who sometimes were **far off**
 - b'. are made **nigh**
- a'. by (**in**) the blood of **Christ**.

D. (*Peace*) 14 For he is our **peace**, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

E. (*Enmity*) 15 Having abolished in his flesh **the enmity**, [even the law of commandments contained in ordinances;]

F. (*One new man*)

- a. for to make in himself of **twain one** new man, so **making peace**;
- a'. 16 And that he might **reconcile both** unto God in **one** body by the cross,

E'. (*Enmity*) having slain **the enmity** thereby:

D'. (*Peace*)

- a. 17 And came and preached **peace** to you which were **afar off**,
- a'. and (Gk **peace**) to them that were **nigh**.

C'. (*Through Christ*) 18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

B'. (*Strangers*)

- a. 19 Now therefore **ye are no more strangers and foreigners**,
- a'. but (Gk **you are**) **fellowcitizens** with the saints, and of the household of God;
- b. 20 And are built upon **the foundation** of the apostles and prophets,
- b'. Jesus Christ himself being **the chief corner stone**;

A'. (*Spirit*)

- a. 21 In whom all the **building** fitly framed **together**
 - b. groweth unto **an holy temple in the Lord**:
- a'. 22 In whom ye also are **builded together**
 - b'. for **an habitation of God** through the Spirit.
