These are the words <b>that Moses spoke to all Israel</b></p> <p>B. <b>beyond the Jordan in the wilderness,</b></p> <p>C. <b>in the Arabah</b> opposite Suph, between Paran and Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab. 2 It is eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of Mount Seir to Kadesh-barnea. 3 In the fortieth year, on the first day of the eleventh month, <b>Moses spoke to the people of Israel</b> according to all that the LORD had given him in commandment to them,</p> <p>D. 4 <b>after he had defeated</b></p> <p>E. <b>Sihon the king of the Amorites, who lived in Heshbon,</b></p> <p>F. <b>and Og the king of Bashan, who lived in Ashtaroth and in Edrei.</b></p> <p>G. 5 <b>Beyond the Jordan,</b> in the land of Moab,</p> <p>H. Moses undertook to explain <b>this law,</b> saying,</p>	<p>Deuteronomy 4:44-49 (ESV)</p> <p>H'. <b>This is the law</b> that Moses set before the people of Israel.</p> <p>A'. 45 These are the testimonies, the statutes, and the rules, which <b>Moses spoke to the people of Israel</b> when they came out of Egypt,</p> <p>B'. 46 <b>beyond the Jordan</b></p> <p>E'. in the valley opposite Beth-peor, in <b>the land of Sihon the king of the Amorites, who lived at Heshbon,</b></p> <p>D'. <b>whom Moses</b> and the people of Israel <b>defeated</b> when they came out of Egypt.</p> <p>F'. 47 And they took possession of his land and <b>the land of Og, the king of Bashan,</b> the two kings of the Amorites,</p> <p>G'. who lived to the east <b>beyond the Jordan;</b></p> <p>C'. 48 from Aroer, which is on the edge of the Valley of the Arnon, as far as Mount Sirion (that is, Hermon), 49 together with all <b>the Arabah</b> on the east side of the Jordan as far as the Sea of <b>the Arabah,</b> under the slopes of Pisgah.</p>
