

The Parallelism of Genesis 6:9 – 9:26 to Genesis 18:16 – 19:38

- A) Genesis 6:9 – This is the genealogy of Noah. **Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations.** Noah walked with God.
- B) Genesis 6:13-22 – States the **end of all flesh is come before me**, for the earth is **filled with violence** through them; and behold, **I am about to do destroy them** from the earth.
- C) Genesis 7:13-16 – This passage describes how Noah along with Shem, ham, and Japheth, Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons **went into the ark so that they could save their lives from the flood.** Also all of the animals entered the ark so that they could be saved from the destruction of the flood
- D) Genesis 7:17-24 – Describes how **all life on the earth perished in the flood.**
- E) Genesis 8:1 – Then **God remembered Noah**, and every living thing, and all the animals that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided.
- F) Genesis 8:4 – States that **the ark came to rest** in the seventh month on the 17th day of the month, **upon the mountains of Ararat**
- G) Genesis 9:20-21 – States that Noah, the man of the earth, debased himself and planted a vineyard. **He drank of the wine and became drunk**, and he uncovered himself within his tent. Furthermore, **Ham did something to Noah during his drunken stupor** (So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done to him!)
- A') Genesis 18:23-24 – 23 And Abraham came near and said, "**Would You also destroy the righteous with the wicked?** 24 Suppose there were fifty righteous within the city; would You also destroy the place and not spare it for the fifty righteous that were in it?
- B') Genesis 19:13 – 13 For **we will destroy this place**, because **the outcry against them has grown great** before the face of the LORD, and the LORD **has sent us to destroy it."**
- C') Genesis 19:14-22 – This is a story about how the **Angels saved lots his daughters and his wife from the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah by taking them out of the cities.**

D') Genesis 19:23-28 – Describes how ***all the people of Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed by the sulfur***. In both stories ***people were destroyed by something that rained down on them from heaven***.

E') Genesis 19:29 – And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that ***God remembered Abraham***, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when He overthrew the cities in which Lot had dwelt.

F') Genesis 19:30 – States how Lot went up from Zohar and ***settled on the mountain***, his two daughters with him

G') Genesis 19:31-36 – Describes how ***Lot's daughters made him drunk with wine*** on two different occasions. ***Furthermore, they had relations with him!***

This parallelism shed's insight on Ham's sin. Comparing elements G/G' seems to point to incest as the sin of Ham.
