Luke 24:13-52 (NASB)

- **A**. ¹³ And behold, two of them were going that very day to a village named Emmaus, which was about seven miles from <u>Jerusalem</u>.
- **B**. ¹⁴ And they were conversing with each other about all these things which had taken place. ¹⁵ And it came about that while they were conversing and discussing, <u>Jesus Himself approached</u>, and <u>began traveling with them</u>. ¹⁶ But their eyes were prevented from recognizing Him.
- **C**. ¹⁷ And He said to them, "What are these words that you are exchanging with one another as you are walking?" And they stood still, looking sad. ¹⁸ And one of them, named Cleopas, answered and said to Him, "Are You the only one visiting Jerusalem and unaware of the things which have happened here in these days?" ¹⁹ And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "The things about Jesus the Nazarene [The Son], who was a prophet mighty (dunatos) in deed and word in the sight of God and all the people,
- **D**. ²⁰ and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him up to the sentence of death, and <u>crucified Him</u>. ²¹ "But we were hoping that it was <u>He who was going to redeem Israel</u>.
- **E**. Indeed, besides all this, it is the <u>third day</u> since these things happened. ²² "But also some women among us amazed us. When they were at the tomb early in the morning, ²³ and did not find His body, they came, saying that they had also seen a vision of angels, who said that <u>He was alive</u>. ²⁴ "And some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just exactly as the women also had said; but Him they did not see."
- **F.** ²⁵ And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in <u>all that the prophets have spoken!</u> ²⁶ "Was it not necessary for <u>the Christ to suffer</u> these things and to enter into His glory?"
- **G**. ²⁷ And beginning with Moses and with all the prophets,
- **H**. He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.
- **I**. ²⁸ And they approached the village where they were going, and He acted as though He would go farther. ²⁹ And they urged Him, saying, "Stay with us, for it is *getting* toward evening, and the day ¹ is now nearly over." And He went in to stay with them. ³⁰ And it came about that when He had reclined *at the table* with them, He took the <u>bread</u> and blessed *it*, and breaking *it*, He *began* giving *it* to them.
- **J**. ³¹ And their eyes were opened and they recognized Him; {Sight; Recognition}
- **K**. and He vanished from their sight.
- **L**. ³² And they said to one another, "Were not our hearts burning within us while He was speaking to us <u>on the road</u>, while He was explaining the Scriptures to us?"
- **X**. ³³ And they arose that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found gathered together the eleven and those who were with them, ³⁴ saying, "*The Lord has really risen*, and has appeared to Simon."
- **L'**. ³⁵ And they *began* to relate their experiences <u>on the road</u> and how He was recognized by them in the breaking of the bread.
- K'. 36 And while they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst.
- **J'**. ³⁷ But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were <u>seeing a spirit</u>. ³⁸ And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? ³⁹ "See My hands and My feet, that

- it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." ⁴⁰ And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet. ⁴¹ And while they still could not believe it for joy and were marveling, {Touch & Sight; Difficulty with Recognition}
- **l**'. He said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" ⁴² And they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish; ⁴³ and He took it and ate *it* before them.
- **H'**. ⁴⁴ Now He said to them, "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are <u>written about Me</u>
- G'. in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."
- **F'**. ⁴⁵ Then He opened their minds to understand <u>the Scriptures</u>, ⁴⁶ and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that <u>the Christ should suffer</u>
- E'. and rise again from the dead the third day;47
- **D'**. and that <u>repentance for forgiveness of sins</u> should be proclaimed in His name <u>to all the nations</u>, <u>beginning from Jerusalem</u>. ⁴⁸ "You are witnesses of these things.
- **C'**. ⁴⁹ "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father [The Father] upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with <u>power (dunamis)</u> from on high [The Holy Spirit]."
- **B'**. ⁵⁰ And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. ⁵¹ And it came about that while He was blessing them, <u>He parted from them</u>.
- **A'**. ⁵² And they returned to Jerusalem with great joy, ⁵³ and were continually in the temple, praising God.
