Chiasm - Revelation 22:7-21

A focuses on Jesus' words: I am coming soon. Possibly, "Blessed" in A parallels the A' blessing in 21.

B focuses on the words of this book. They are also John's direct words on both sides.

C focuses on the repeated passive imperative let (3x in Greek in C, 4x in C').

D focuses on Jesus' words on both sides and on the <u>I am</u> statements.

E and **E'** are the blessing and the curse. Entering ($\epsilon i \varsigma$) is contrasted by the outside ($\dot{\epsilon} \xi \omega$).

A 7 "And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

B ⁸ I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me, ⁹ but he said to me, "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

C ¹⁰ And he said to me, "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near. ¹¹ Let the evildoer still do evil, and [let] the filthy still be filthy, and [let] the righteous still do right, and [let] the holy still be holy."

D ¹² "Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay each one for what he has done. ¹³ <u>I am</u> the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."

E ¹⁴ Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates.

E' 15 Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and the sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

 D'^{16} "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. <u>I am</u> the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."

C' ¹⁷ The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And **let** the one who hears say, "Come." And **let** the one who is thirsty come; **let** the one who desires take the water of life without price.

B' ¹⁸ I warn everyone who hears <u>the words</u> of the prophecy of <u>this book</u>: if anyone adds to them, <u>God</u> will add to him the plagues described in <u>this book</u>, ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from <u>the words of the book</u> of this prophecy, <u>God</u> will take away his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in <u>this book</u>.

A' ²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! ²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen.
